CREDITS

3 college credits can be earned through the completion of each Accelerator Program course. The college credits earned may be transferable to other institutions.

ENROLLMENT

Class enrollment will be limited to 27 students per class.

REQUIREMENTS

The Accelerator Program courses are available to high school juniors and seniors. A minimum grade point average of 3.0 is required to be eligible to participate in the program. Other students may be considered, please contact us about any students that fall outside of these parameters.

COST AND PAYMENT

WITHDRAWAL POLICY
